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Mastering the Posterior Capsule: Thinking out of the Bag Paradigm Shift

The anterior hyaloid membrane defines the two-chambered eye. The posterior capsule is redundant. Posterior optic capture of an intraocular lens after cataract removal controls fibrosis, eliminates secondary visual axis obscuration, allows prediction and stability of intraocular lens position, and maintains an intact anterior hyaloid for life.
