Benign metastizing Leiomyoma of the Lung {BML}

Background:

This is a study of multiple cases diagnosed with BML, highlighting the pathogenesis, diagnosis, management and prognosis for each case.

Objective:

To raise the knowledge of a rare lung pathology and explain how to diagnose and manage properly.

Method:

Data was collected from multiple case reports and scoping reviews.

Conclusion:

Benign metastasizing leiomyoma is a uterine leiomyoma with pulmonary metastasis occurring in young adulthood, especially during the premenopausal period. The lung is the most common site of involvement. The clinical course of BML varies from a chronic asymptomatic course to a rapid progression leading to respiratory failure and death.
